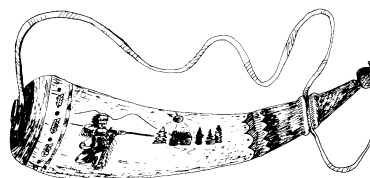

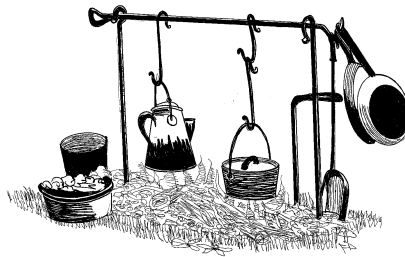
~ LOTS OF MISCELLANEOUS NIFTY INFORMATION ~

- ❖ You must bring your own cobbler and cooking gear for the Family Cobbler Contest.
- ❖ After the cobblers have been judged, we will eatum' up after the Dutch Oven Share.
- ❖ Great time to test out that new recipe or new Dutch oven. Either way, we are all going to enjoy this one.

- ❖ Nobody goes anywhere alone – use the “Buddy System”.
- ❖ Parents please keep a constant vigil on your children.
- ❖ Bring your own drinking and wash water. We will try to have extra water available.
- ❖ Bears, no more than usual. Keep your food properly stored. DO NOT keep food in lodges or tents. Change clothing before sleeping. DO NOT store soiled clothing where you sleep.
- ❖ If you have an FCF name, i.e. “Three Minks”, “Buffalo Warrior”, please use it to keep the spirit of the outing.
- ❖ Bring whatever you have to camp in, modern tents, teepees, lean-to, and even camp trailers, are all welcome.
- ❖ Remember the Royal Ranger Rule – “Leave the camp better than you found it”. We are always inspected by the Forest Ranger and they will report any violations back to us.
- ❖ You must gather or bring all your own firewood and/or fuel.
- ❖ On Saturday we all need to keep lunch quick and easy to keep the events on schedule and running smoothly.

OUTFITTING

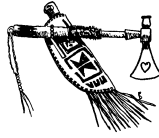

LOVE BLANKET

The purpose of the Love Blanket is to give someone a special blessing in the form of a gift.

Here is how it works:

- ❖ We have a blanket spread out on the ground in front of the fellowship fire in the evening service.
- ❖ Whoever wants to can lay a gift on the blanket.
- ❖ At the designated time, we will announce if anyone has a gift on the Love Blanket to come forward.
- ❖ He/she will then take the gift and call the person up to the Love Blanket they want to present the gift to.
- ❖ You should be able to give a *brief* testimony to explain why you are giving this gift.
- ❖ We encourage the use of the Love Blanket but we ask that you keep it brief, to the point, and to limit your gifts to only two (2) people.

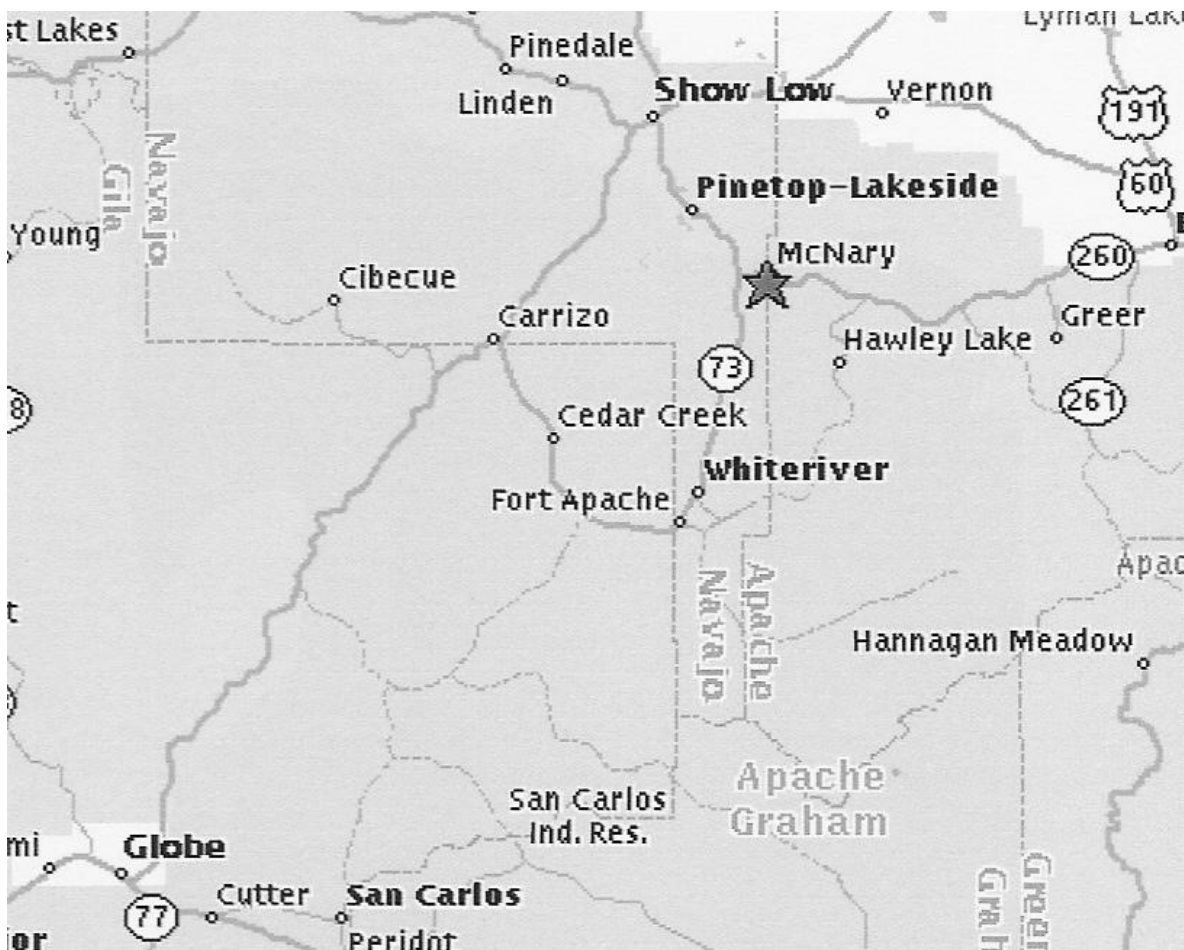
